





# SPECIALIST TRAINING COURSE CALL FOR ENTRIES 2020-2021

#### **SADDLERY**

This training speciality provides pupils with the knowledge they need to make and repair different saddlery items for horse riding and maintaining carriages. It also enables them to learn about the tools and materials, and to apply specific techniques and procedures.

The duration of the course is of three years, and pupils will receive practical and theoretical lessons in the Royal School's harness workshop in a progressive form coherent to their learning process. They will also learn the techniques and history of the horse and carriage and hypology.

#### **GENERAL TERMS AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

For the course 2020-2021 are offered THREE vacancies. They will be assigned to the applicants who success all the requirements and get the best marks in the entrance exams

The requirements to apply for a vacancy are the following:

- Have completed ESO education (Compulsory Secondary Education).
- Be aged between 16 and 30 years old.
- Declaring that they do not suffer from any illness that may impede working with horses and teams.
- Have adequate knowledge of Spanish in order to get the maximum benefit from lessons.
- Pass the entrance exam.

#### **ENTRANCE EXAM**

The applicants must complete a theoretical-practical part exam, followed by a personal interview.

The theoretical-practical exam will be of the following subjects:

- Knowledge of the tools and materials.
- Knowledge of the different horse equipment made in a saddler workshop.
- Hand-sewing practice.







#### **REGISTRATION AND EXAM FEES**

The amount of sixty (60) Euros is required as application and exam fee. A person can only apply for Saddlery Specialty per academic year.

#### REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR REGISTRATION

- The application duly completed.
- Certified photocopy of the qualification required.
- Medical certificate.
- Proof of payment of the admission fees.
- Authorization from parents or tutors in case of underage.
- Photocopy of identity document or passport.
- 2 Photos (passport size).

Those applicants of foreign nationality must demonstrate their Spanish ability level to be able to get the maximum benefit from the course.

Those pupils registered in a Specialist Training Course at the School, will be not able to apply for any other course offered by the Institution.

#### **ECONOMIC CONDITIONS**

The entry fee for the Specialist Training Course in Saddlery is 800€ per year, to be paid in instalments at the beginning of the course.







## DATES OF SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATIONS AND ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS

The date of submission of applications to take part in the entrance examinations starts on Monday, 27<sup>th</sup> April until, at least, 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2020.

The dates for the entrance examinations will be published online after all restrictions related mobility due to the health alert have been lifted. (It will not take place before the 15<sup>th</sup> of September 2020).
