### **GENERAL TERMS FOR ENTERING IN THE ADMISSION TESTS**

The pupils must present the appropriate documentation on the day of the admission tests, or they will not be allowed to take their tests, and also the Current license (federated card) from the Royal Spanish Equestrian Federation (except Saddlery applicants).

Deadline for submission of documentation: Tuesday 15 September. No more applications related to this announcement will be accepted after the deadline for submission.

All the Specialties' exams and tests will be held in Spanish language.

The exams' results will be communicated to the applicants by phone or email.

The applicants may request the review of their exams' results in person in our facilities. The review for the theoretical exam will be on the same day of examinations, and the review for the practical exam with prior appointment and within the two working days following the publication of the provisional results.

In addition to the applicants admitted, it also will be informed the applicants placed on the reserve list, i.e. those applicants who have passed the admission exams but have not obtained a place. The applicants on the reserve list could be admitted if any official applicant admitted would reject her/his place. The possible substitutions could be performed within 6 months once the courses have been started.

The Royal School reserves the right to postpone, cancel or modify the general terms and/or the dates of the tests if the competent authorities so advised, due to health conditions.
