



SPECIALIST TRAINING COURSE CALL FOR ENTRIES 2021-2022

HORSEMANSHIP

This training provides the participants with the knowledge they need to achieve a broader education as a dressage rider, enabling them to develop their careers professionally. It is offered two options: the first option is of two years and the second of four years, and every year begins a new promotion.

The course is structured in two cycles, each of them of two school years. Although the overarching element is the practice of Dressage, the first course constitutes an approach to the basic aspects, and with the second course, pupils obtain a specialization in educational, recreational and sports sectors.

During the training, the pupils take part in many of the Royal School's activities: galas, exhibition performances, events or reportages, and going outs to the competitions.

VANCIES AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

For the **course 2021-2022** are offered **SENVENTEEN (17) vacancies**. They will be assigned to the applicants who success all requirements and get the best marks in the entrance exams.

- $_{\odot}$ SIX (6) FOR THE COURSE AT THE ROYAL SCHOOL IN JEREZ DE LA FRONTERA
 - **TWO (2)** vacancies are reserved for the applicants with ESO education, and it has a duration of two years.
 - **FOUR (4)** vacancies are for the applicants with Bachiller Education or equivalent, and it has a duration of four years.
- ELEVEN (11) FOR THE COURSE IN THE CAMPUS REAL ESCUELA-TORRELUNA EL MARENGO IN CARMONA.
 - **THREE (3)** vacancies are reserved for the applicants with ESO education, and it has a duration of two years.
 - **EIGHT (8)** vacancies are for the applicants with Bachiller Education or equivalent, and it has a duration of four years.







The requirements to apply for a vacancy are the following:

- Have completed ESO education (Compulsory Secondary Education), Bachiller (Baccalaureate) or equivalent*.
- Be aged between 16 and 24 years old.
- Declaring that the applicant does not suffer from any illness that may impede working with horses and teams.
- Pass the entrance exam.

* The equivalences will only be accepted for Bachiller: <u>check Equivalences.</u>

- Certified photocopy of the qualification required.
- Medical certificate.
- Proof(s) of payment of the admission fees.
- Authorization from parents or tutors in case of underage.
- Photocopy of identity document or passport.
- 2 Photos (passport size).

EXAM FEES

The amount of sixty (60) Euros is required as application and exam fee for Horsemanship Specialty.

A person can apply for all the specialties at the same time, except for Saddlery, paying the amount established for each Specialty in the following bank account:

ENTRANCE EXAM

The applicants must complete two exams: a theoretical part and a practical part.

- <u>Theoretical exam</u>: This consists of thirty (30) questions dealing with topics referenced in the bibliography.
- <u>Practical exam</u>: It consists of executing a Classical Dressage test (attached to this document) on a 60 X 20 m. track.

DATES FOR SUBMISSIONS OF THE APPLICATIONS AND ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS

The application submission period is from Tuesday 1st June to Wednesday 8th September 2021.

The tests will be held at the Royal School Foundation, Avda. Duque de Abrantes on September 13rd, 14th and 15th with horses of this Foundation.

GENERAL BASIS, COMMUNICATION OF RESULTS AND BEGINNING OF THE COURSE

The applicant must come the day of the entrance examinations with the ID card/Passport and the current federated card.

Those applicants of foreign nationality must demonstrate their Spanish ability level to be able to get the maximum benefit from the course.

Those pupils already registered in a Specialist Training Course at the School, will be not able to apply for any other course offered by the Institution, and if they do it, will lose their right to registration.







The applicants may request in person a review of their exams, being for the theoretical test on the same day of the exam and for the practical test by appointment during the following work days after the exam day.

The results will be communicated to the applicants by telephone and by email.

The Royal School reserves the right to delay and/or stop the general basis and the dates of holding the tests if the competent authorities would advise it due to the health conditions.

The course begins on Monday 4th, October 2021.
