





SPECIALIST TRAINING COURSE CALL FOR ENTRIES 2023-2024

HORSEMANSHIP

This training provides the participants with the knowledge they need to achieve a broader education as a dressage rider, enabling them to develop their careers professionally. This training is extended to four years.

The course is structured in two cycles, each of them of two school years. Although the overarching element is the practice of Dressage, the first course constitutes an approach to the basic aspects, and with the second course, pupils obtain a specialization in educational, recreational and sports sectors.

During the training, the pupils take part in many of the Royal School's activities: galas, exhibition performances, events or reportages, and going outs to the competitions.

VACANCIES AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

For the **course 2023-2024** are offered FOURTEEN vacancies for students who get the best ratings

- FOUR (4) FOR THE COURSE AT THE ROYAL SCHOOL:
- THREE (3) are reserved for the applicants with Bachiller Education or equivalent. It has a duration of four years.
- ONE (1) is reserved for the applicants with ESO Education. It has a duration of two years.
- TEN (10) FOR THE COURSE AT THE CAMPUS REAL ESCUELA-TORRELUNA IN CARMONA*. Reserved for applicants with ESO Education. It has a duration of two years.
- * The 2024-2025 course may be carried out at the Campus site or at the Jerez site, according to availability.







The requirements to apply for a vacancy are the following:

- Have completed ESO, Bachiller (Baccalaureate) or equivalent.
- Be aged between 16 and 24 years old.
- Declaring that the applicant does not suffer from any illness that may impede working with horses and teams.

- Proof(s) of payment of the admission fees.
- Authorization from parents or tutors in case of underage.

EXAM FEES

The amount of sixty (60) Euros is required as application and exam fee for Horsemanship Specialty.

DATES FOR SUBMISSIONS OF THE APPLICATIONS AND ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS

The application submission period is from Wednesday, June 14 until Wednesday, September 6, 2023.

The tests will be held on <u>Wednesday 13 of September</u> at the Royal School site and with horses of the School.

GENERAL BASIS, COMMUNICATION OF RESULTS AND BEGINNING OF THE COURSE

The applicant must come the day of the entrance examinations with the ID card/Passport and the current federated card.

Those applicants of foreign nationality must demonstrate their Spanish ability level to be able to get the maximum benefit from the course.

The applicants may request in person a review of their exams, being for the theoretical test on the same day of the exam and for the practical test by previous appointment during the following working days after the exam day.

The results will be communicated to the applicants by telephone and by email.

The course begins on Monday, October 2, 2023.

ECONOMIC CONDITIONS

The entry fee for the Specialist Training Course in Horsemanship is:

- Jerez: 2,500 € per year.
- Campus Real Escuela-Torreluna: 4,000 € per year.

This amount must be fully paid at the beginning of the course. Possibility of applying for bank financing of the course fee.







ENTRANCE EXAM

The applicants must complete two exams: a theoretical part and a practical part.

■ <u>Theoretical exam</u>: This consists of thirty (30) questions dealing with topics referenced in the bibliography, one point (1) each question of a test-exam. To have the option of carrying out the following exam, the applicant must have obtained a mark of more of the 66% in the test-exam.

- Practical exam: It consists of executing a Classical Dressage test (attached to this
 document) on a 60 X 20 m. track. This exercise will be done from memory and each
 applicant will be assigned a horse by public drawing.
 - This test is judged by five teachers from this Foundation. The highest and the lowest scores obtained will be excluded, being calculated the average with the other three remaining scores.
- FINAL MARK AND EXAMRESULTS. This will be the average of the marks obtained in the theoretical and practical exercises, considering that the former counts for 30% of the mark and the latter for 70%. The assignation of places will be strictly by order of marks. If two applicants obtain the same final mark, the best mark achieved in the practical test shall be decisive, and in case of a tie, it will be determined by the best average of the total marks obtained in the practical test.
