



# SPECIALIST TRAINING COURSES PROPRIETARY PROGRAMS OF THE ROYAL SCHOOL 2025–2026 CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

# **EQUINE CLINICAL ASSISTANT**

It aims to train students to perform basic care for horses related to hygiene, preventive medicine, and first aid.

The course lasts for one year, during which both theoretical and mainly practical knowledge will be provided. Its functions range from supporting the clinical tasks of the veterinarian in activities related to medical assistance, emergency care, first aid, and the care and preparation for pre- and post-operative procedures, to maintaining the clinical facilities concerning hygiene, disinfection, and asepsis of both the facilities and the equipment.

## PLACES AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

For the **2025-2026 academic year**, **FOUR places** are announced, which will be filled by the candidates who achieve the highest scores in the entrance exams.

The requirements to apply for a place are the following:

- Applicants must have completed ESO (Compulsory Secondary Education).
- Be aged between 16 and 28 years old.
- Not suffer from any medical conditions that would prevent safe interaction with horses and equipment

- A photocopy of the required academic qualification
- Official medical certificate





- Proof of payment of examination fees
- Parental or guardian authorization (if the applicant is underage)
- A photocopy of the National ID (DNI/NIE) or passport
- Two passport-sized photographs

### **EXAMINATION FEES**

The registration and examination fee for the Equine Clinical Assistant Specialty is set at thirty (30) euros. Candidates may apply for all specialties offered by the Royal School, except for Saddlery, by paying the corresponding fee for each specialty into the following bank account:

### **DEADLINES FOR APPLICATION SUBMISSION AND EXAM DATES**

The application submission period will be open FROM TUESDAY, 24 JUNE 2025 TO THURSDAY, 11 SEPTEMBER 2025.

The entrance examinations will take place at the facilities of the Royal School, located on Avenida Duque de Abrantes, **on Tuesday, 16 September 2025.** 

### NOTIFICATION OF RESULTS AND COMMENCEMENT OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR

The results will be communicated by phone and email. Once the selection process is completed, each applicant will be informed—by phone and via the email address provided—of the full list of participants' scores, including the ranking order and a pseudonymized identification number.

Applicants may request a review of their examinations and have the right to know the results obtained by the other participants, as well as the documentation used as the basis for the scoring, particularly in relation to those candidates who received higher marks.

The course will begin on Wednesday, 1 October 2025





## **TUITION FEES**

The annual tuition fee for the Equine Clinical Assistant Specialty is €800.

### **REGULATIONS**

The formalization of enrolment in the course implies acceptance of the Internal Regulations, which include all elements related to the selection period, class attendance, discipline and attitude, learning and aptitude, treatment of staff and teaching materials, dress code, behaviour, as well as those deriving from student status. The Royal School reserves the right to take disciplinary measures in the event of violations of the established rules and regulations.

### **ENTRANCE EXAMS**

For the different tests, you must bring your DNI or NIE and the valid federation card.

The examinations will comprise the following:

- Theoretical exam: This consists of thirty (30) questions covering topics included in the bibliography, one point (1) each question of a test-exam.
  Bibliography: Stafford, Christine y Robert Oliver: El cuidado y manejo del caballo. 2º ed. Madrid: Tutor, 2007. ISBN: 978-84-7902-345-7
- Practical exam:
  - Washing a horse and facilities.
  - Lunging a horse and handling in the right-hand.
  - Bandaging a horse.

This exam is evaluated by a teacher from the Royal School Foundation.

FINAL MARK AND TESTS RESULTS: The final mark will be the result of calculating the average of the scores obtained in the practical and theoretical exercises, considering that the practical test contributes 75% to the total and the theoretical test 25%. Places will be assigned strictly according to the ranking of scores. In the event that two candidates obtain the same final mark, the higher score in the practical test will decide.
